## PHYSICAL CHARACTERISTICS

Canopy potential: 20' wide

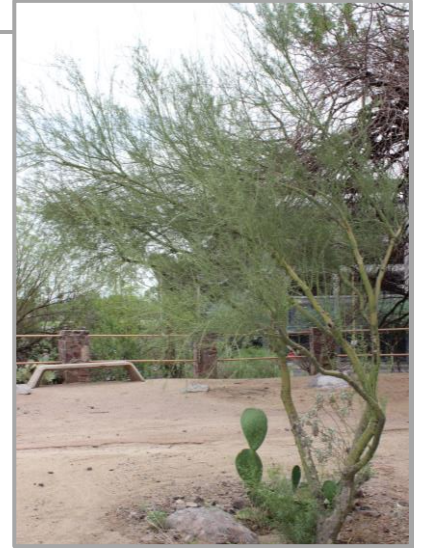
Annual Growth Rate: 36"

Powerline Compatible: 20' from base

Root Damage Potential: Low

Leaves: Odd, Light Green, Deciduous.

Flowers: Showy. Yellow. Flowers in Spring.



## ENVIRONMENTAL CHARACTERISTICS

Water Use: Low

Edible Fruit Producing: Yes, slender with rounded lumps where the seeds form, green when young, brown when mature.

Allergenic: High

BVOC Emissions: Moderate

Sonoran Desert Native: Yes

Invasive Species: No

Tree Care: Plant in full sun to partial shade. Tolerant of alkaline soils. Drought tolerant but may need watering during the drier summer months.
