Canopy potential: 30' – 50' wide

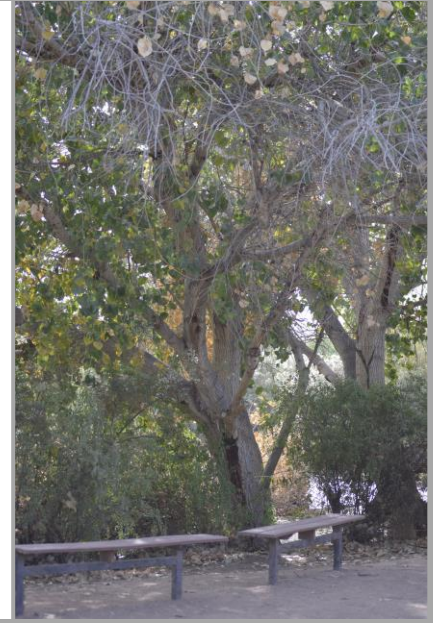
Annual Growth Rate: 36"

Powerline Compatible: 40' – 80' from base

Root Damage Potential: High

Leaves: Light green, golden or yellow or orange, deciduous.

Flowers: Inconspicuous. Flowers in Spring or Winter.
Has either male or female reproductive parts
