

Rough-Barked Arizona Cypress (Common Name)

Callitropsis arizonica (Scientific Name)



PHYSICAL CHARACTERISTICS

Canopy potential: 20' wide

Annual Growth Rate: 12" – 36"

Powerline Compatible: 40' – 50' from base

Root Damage Potential: Low

Leaves: Scalelike tiny 1/8" long. Grayish or bluish green. Pit with resin gland.

Flowers: 3/8-1 1/8" wide. Gray to brown.
