

Shoestring Acacia or Dalby / River Myall (Common Name)



Acacia stenophylla (Scientific Name)

PHYSICAL CHARACTERISTICS

Canopy potential: 10' – 20' wide

Annual Growth Rate: 36"

Powerline Compatible: 20' – 30' from base

Root Damage Potential: Low

Leaves: Gray up to 16 inches long and linear.

Flowers: One-half inch small, cream-yellow puffball.

Tree Care: Plant in full sun, in well-drained soil. Water in the drier summer months once every two weeks. Stake and prune the tree when young for structural integrity.
